DEMONSTRATE KNOWLEDGE OF DRUG AND/OR ALCOHOL USE IN THE WORKPLACE

1. Controlled drugs are defined in terms of their classifications
2. The types of offences and penalties specified by the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975, Land Transport Act and relevant Acts pertaining to particular industries
3. Identifying an employees obligations and an employer has when breaches occur
4. Current trends, drug paraphernalia, terminology, techniques for dealing and using controlled drugs e.g. Methamphetamine, Morphine, Cannabis, Party Pills etc
5. Terms that apply to dealing with offences involving controlled drugs are explained
6. Personal behaviours exhibited by staff are described in terms of being under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs
7. Protocols for dealing with an individual are described in terms of approaching an individual under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol
8. Management of workers is described in terms of individual strategies for safer alcohol and drugs
9. External assistance is described in terms of availability for drug and/or alcohol abuse and/or addiction
10. Assessing persons under the influence of alcohol/drugs – (Assessment forms and documentation)
